Chopped Oak is an exceptionally rustic veneer with a deeply textured face. Indentations and imperfections, chops and scratches, have been roll-pressed into the sheets to give them a historic feel. The mismatched oak is laid in a random pattern to complete the look. This veneer is deliberately unfinished and can take any type of stain, oil, or lacquer. Matching edge tapes are available.

Handling & Application / Rustica, despite being a very durable product is still vulnerable to moisture and UV. Consequently it is the users responsibility to ensure the sheets are sealed with a protective coating to give the product the necessary protection from UV moisture and for the desired performance. This is a natural product that can be affected by changes in weather conditions: moisture and temperature. Increased moisture content temperature variation may cause internal stresses causing previously flat sheets to bow.

At Plymasters, precautions are taken to minimise this effect. However, once the panel has left our warehouse we cannot guarantee sheets to remain flat unless fastened. This is particularly important where free standing kitchen/cabinet doors are concerned. When storing panels, stack on a firm raised base with enough support to prevent sagging. Cover the pallet to protect top and edges.
